Travel to Sandpiper Bay March 20

The region known as the South Brunswick Islands appears to have been a favorite playground for course designer Dan Maples. From the scenic and well-known Oyster Bay and Marsh Harbour courses to the two layouts at The Pearl to one beautiful

course at Sea Trail Plantation to the Sandpiper Bay complex, it is obvious that locals fell in love with Maples' style and genius. He appears to have been right at home with the plentiful marshes, old oak forests, tidal creeks and rivers and many fresh water lakes.

Sandpiper Bay, a layout perhaps not as well-known as Oyster Bay or Marsh Harbour, stands as an excellent example of Maples design prowess with its rolling, contoured fairways, beautifully sculpted bunkers

and 40 acres of lakes. Like other Maples designs in the area, the course serves as a natural wildlife habitat with numerous species of birds and other animals.

Sandpiper Bay has been recognized in the past for having the best overall course conditions, service to golfers and staff friendliness on the Grand Strand. The layout always seems to be in superb condition with some of the finest bent grass greens in the region. Sandpiper Bay management is offering Barefoot Members a special rate of \$35.00 per person for the March 20 Travel Day. **Call 843-390-3200 by March 18, 12:00 noon to reserve your foursome. Tee times begin at 8:06 am and continue in nine minute increments. A strict 48-hour cancellation policy is in effect.**

Charity Tournament Back at Barefoot

Spring must not be far away because we're once again announcing the return of the Hootie and the Blowfish Monday after the Masters Tournament to Barefoot Resort. Slated for April 14 at the Dye Club, the popular charity tournament is poised to raise more record funding for deserving organizations such as the Hootie and the Blowfish Foundation, South Carolina Junior Golf Association and other charities, all of which focus on improving golfing and educational opportunities for young people. The 2007 event realized \$458,000 in charitable donations, another record-breaking amount. Over the tournament's history, over \$3 million has been donated to charities. In 2007 and for the second straight year, a sellout crowd of over 6,000 fans spread over the Dye Club grounds to watch their favorite pro golfer, celebrity or sports star.

Since the event is set up as a Pro-Am, tournament officials are able to invite celebrity athletes and other celebrities to team up with PGA Tour Golfers and the amateur participants who make special contributions to the event. This mix not only makes for some outstanding golf but also, on occasion, some very interesting entertainment for the spectators. Besides the Hootie and the Blowfish Band Members, past tournaments have featured appearances by athlete celebrities Johnny Bench, John Elway, Brett Favre, Dan Marino, Jim McMahon, Sterling Sharpe, Steve Spurrier, Michael Strahan and Michael Waltrip. Also participating in past years from the celebrity side are Alice Cooper, Samuel L. Jackson, Branford Marsalis, Edwin McCain, Bill Murray, Dan Patrick, and Stuart Scott. The celebrities have been paired over the years with Pro Golf greats Woody Austin, Fred Couples, John Daly, Fred Funk, Robert Gamez, J.B. Holmes, Matt Kuchar, Arnold Palmer, D.J. Trahan and Tom Watson to name just a few. The team of Ricky Barnes and Sterling Sharpe won the 2007 event in a playoff over Erica Blasberg (LPGA) and Hootie Band Member Dean Felber.

Selling Your Barefoot Resort Property?

Please Read the Information Below

We are currently experiencing a time where there are numerous Barefoot Resort properties being placed on the market for sale. Fortunately, Barefoot Resort & Golf members have an incentive in an attached membership which could make their property more attractive than one lacking a membership. With the sale of a property owned by a Resort Member comes the opportunity for the new owner to take over the membership by paying a small transfer fee. **The current owner relinquishes the membership attached to the property upon sale.**

Please know that the Membership Dept. is not aware of a property sale unless the current owner/member, new owner or real estate agent(s) make us aware of the transaction. It is important that the current owner/member alert the prospective buyer that the membership is available with the property. Most owner/members are using the membership as a tool to make their property more attractive since the majority of prospective Resort buyers wish to have some relationship with the Golf Club. The transfer of membership to a new owner requires the payment of a transfer fee which is currently 10% of the full membership value (currently \$2,000). It is also necessary for the new owner to complete the appropriate paperwork in order to obtain the membership.

To verify that a property sale has taken place and to obtain the necessary information, the Membership Dept. requires a copy of the first page of the closing HUD settlement statement be submitted to the Dept. as soon after closing as possible. This verifies the transaction took place, gives the name of the seller, name of buyer and exact closing date.

Obviously, the new owner must wait until after closing to take the membership and has 60 days following closing to do so. The current owner/member should take the responsibility of forwarding the first page of the HUD settlement statement to the Membership Dept. by fax or postal service.
