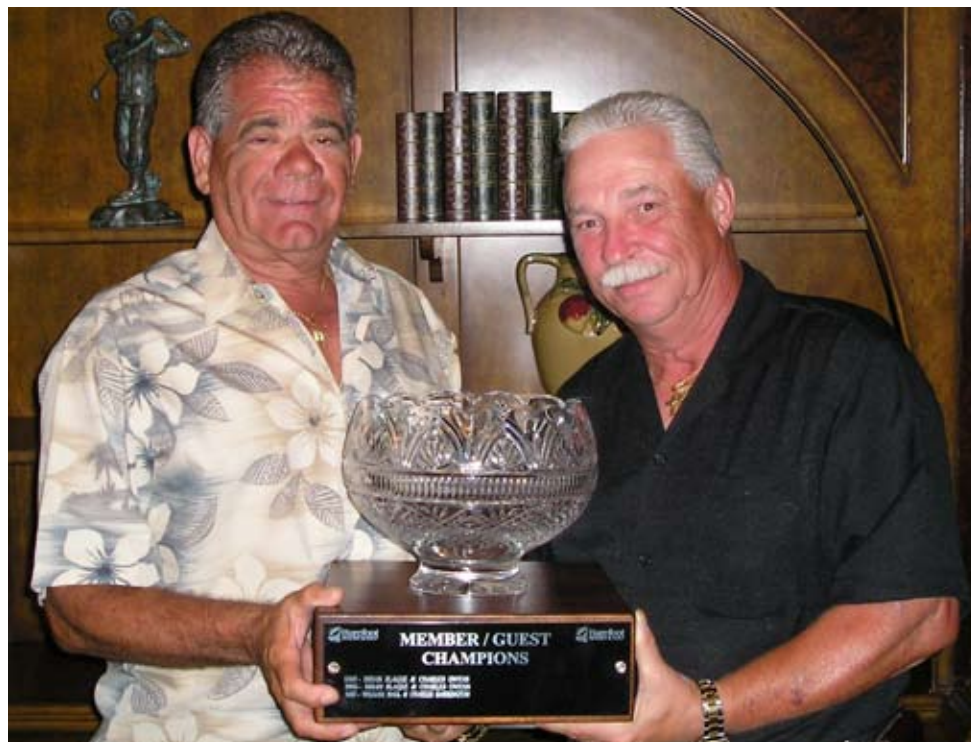
On the final evening of the tournament week-

Toward the end of each calendar year, management and owners discuss the current dues levels and determine what, if any, adjustments need to be made. The last increase for dues took place on January 1, 2008. On January 1, 2009, membership dues for the Resort Membership will be as follows:

Golf and Social Level
\$125.00 per month (increase of \$5.00)

Social Only Level
\$55.00 per month (stays the same)

Inactive for Multiple Property Owners -
\$25.00 per month (stays the same)

The Value of the Membership remains the same at \$20,000.

Celebrate New Year's Eve Mardi Gras Style!

Barefoot Staff is planning a New Year's Eve Celebration at the Barefoot Resort & Golf Clubhouse only this time it has a festive Mardi Gras flavor.

The December 31 party features some new twists besides the Mardi Gras theme. The evening begins with a Cocktail Hour from 7:30 – 8:30 PM complete with Hors d'oeuvres. Dinner is served from 8:30 – 9:30 pm. After dinner, dance up to midnight. Of course, we'll count down to mid-
