Barefoot Resort & Golf is beginning its nineteenth year of operation in the constantly changing and rapidly evolving golf business environment located in the “Golf Capital of the World” Myrtle Beach. ## Message from the Superintendent

To our membership: As we begin our 2019 golf season, we have been working on several projects in order to maintain and improve the condition and quality of our courses. We've been encouraged by the over seeding of the courses in October and November in order to provide a "green grass experience" for our members and customers throughout the winter months. We have purchased and are using several green covers throughout our four golf courses to protect the putting surfaces from the occasional severe weather events that we experience here on the Grand Strand. This will help to insure healthy and productive putting surfaces heading into our Spring golf season. We have also been working on multiple drainage projects on all of the courses which includes tree removal in strategic areas to allow more sunlight on to the courses, replacing existing drainage infrastructure and creating new drainage to allow our courses to dry out. In addition, we are currently replacing damaged cart paths and using new equipment to grind down individual cart path segments that have been displaced by tree roots or other natural occurrences in order to improve your trip around the course. We hope you enjoy these improvements as we work to maintain and improve our courses. Best wishes for a healthy and prosperous 2019!
